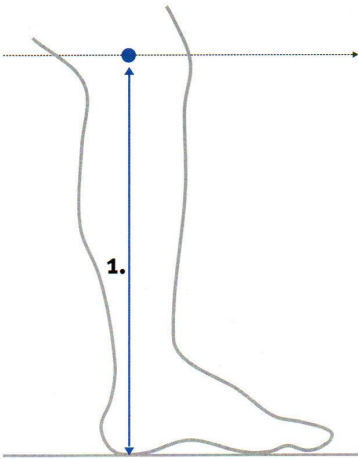


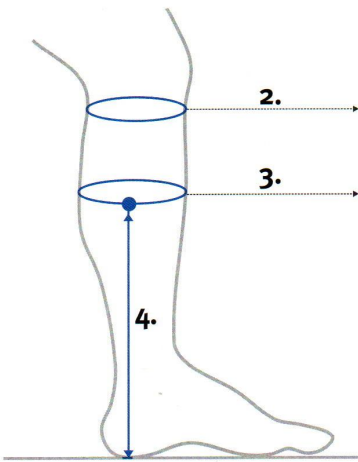
## HEIGHT



Measure the height while seated, bent the leg in a right angle, (measured straight) on the outside of the leg, from the middle of the knee cap till to the bottom. For the dressage bow you have to add 2, 3, 4 or 5 cm to the measured height

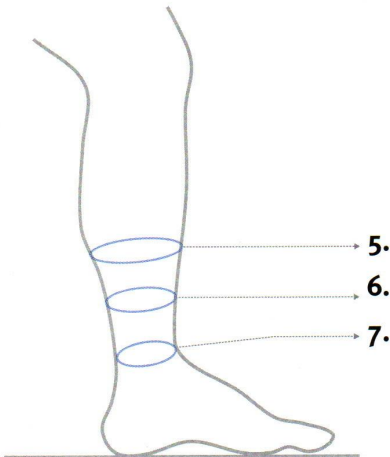

## CALF CIRCUMFERENCE & UPPER CALF

Please measure the calf circumference at the strongest part of the calf. Please note at which height you have measured the calf. The upper calf has to be measured under the knee cap. Please pay attention that there are no wrinkles in the breeches. They can apply a lot!

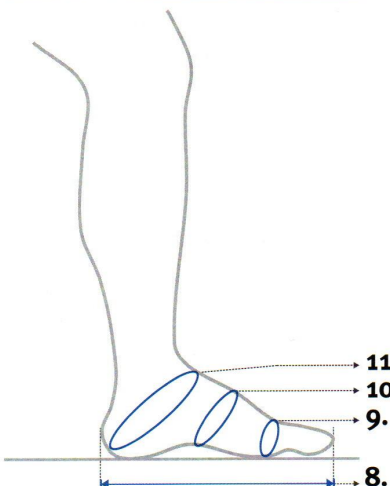


## ANKLE MEASUREMENTS

Please take the ankle measurements with the aid of the Königs glue strip. Please pay attention that the measurements are only an indication for us how slim the ankle should be. We can only keep the measurements if the boots have a zipper at the back.

## FOOT MEASUREMENTS

Please make on the right side an outline of both feet. Then measure the ball on the widest part of the foot, the instep on the highest part at the middle of the foot and the heel circumference from the heel to the area of the entry.
